

Qualified Scholarship Program Of Mississippi County Farm Bureau

One of the primary purposes of Mississippi County Farm Bureau is to promote the development of Agriculture in the state of Missouri and this county. In furtherance of that purpose, the Board of Directors have adopted a scholarship program to encourage the study of agricultural pursuits or other trades and professions necessary to the rural community.

A scholarship will be awarded to an applicant, which will be reviewed, voted on, and chosen by the Scholarship Committee of the Mississippi County Farm Bureau. The scholarship is to be used for post-secondary training (college or vocational training). It is a condition of the scholarship that it must be exclusively used for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and/or equipment required for the course(s).

Applicants must be graduating seniors, who attend school in Mississippi County. Applications will be sent to each High School in the county. If you are in need of an extra copy to apply, stop by the Mississippi County Farm Bureau office and pick up an application. We can also fax or email the application.
